

# **EE Gospel Tract for Palm OS Handhelds**

Version 1.0.1 (first revision)

## ***Installation***

Simply install the DoYouKnow.prc file as you would any other application. You may need to consult the documentation provided with your device. For Palm branded devices, an install tool is provided with the Palm Desktop software that allows you to add new programs to your handheld. The program shows up in the program launcher under the title “DoYouKnow” with an icon that illustrates the two EE question marks.

## ***Program Features***

This program was designed with intent to be used as either an educational tool to help EE trainees learn the outline, or as a medium by which someone is introduced to the Gospel for the first time.

### **On-screen Buttons**

The program always launches into the first page of the presentation. You can use the stylus to select the next page (→) and previous page(←) buttons, or you can just press the up/down buttons on your handheld.

### **Up/Down Hardware Buttons**

These buttons can be used to navigate through the presentation one page at a time. Note that the only way scripture references and other pop-ups are opened is if you tap on them with the stylus.

### **Scripture References**

Scripture versus (and other items) that appear outlined in a dotted box can be selected to display more information. In the case of scripture references it opens the verse. All scripture is referenced from the NIV, and a copyright notice is provided in the software (tap the info (i) box in the title bar of the scripture windows).

### **Menus**

The pull-down menus allow you to jump directly to any major point in the presentation (there are typically two pages per main point). Graffiti shortcuts are provided for each menu item. The shortcut is the first character of the section name, with only one exception. For the growth section, the shortcut is “S”, as in Spiritual growth (that is the only memory aid I can offer).

### **Spiritual Growth Checkpoints**

The section illustrating the five steps to spiritual growth lists the five items with checkboxes. As each item is checked off, a popup appears describing that item. Each popup has the relevant scripture references. Once each item has been

selected, it remains checked until the “Clear checks” button is pressed or the program is re-started. Once all five items have been checked an “End” button appears to exit the presentation. The popup under the Help->About menu is automatically displayed when the user exits through the provided “End” button.

## **Compatibility**

This program has been tested on all versions of the Palm OS back to the original version 1.0 using an emulation tool provided by Palm. There should not be any problems running this program on ANY device that runs the Palm OS. If you find this to not be true, please let us know!!

## **Disclaimer**

This program is intended to be an electronic reproduction of the EE gospel presentation as taught in clinics and presented in the paper version of the tract. Slight modifications were made as appropriate to leverage the handheld as a presentation medium. As the Spiritual Birth Certificate cannot be practically reproduced on the handheld, it has been intentionally omitted. (This was not an oversight. If anyone has any clever ideas as to how they think the spiritual birth certificate should “work”, I am open to suggestions.)
